










# **USS INTREPID**





# Origin of INTREPID Tradition

Since a ship is conceived of as a living thing, and seafaring men have always considered it as such, she must be regarded as a product not only of the craftsmen who built her, the officers and men who man her, but of her ancestry as well. The predecessors of a ship lend to her the name which she bears, and around it are built the traditions, regulations, and records which every subsequent ship of that name must equal, if not excel.

The first INTREPID, a 60-ton ketch captured from the Tripolitans during the Tripolitan War by the American schooner ENTERPRISE, was the main character of "the most bold and daring act of the age." Without a shot being fired, INTREPID, under the command of Lt. Stephan Decatur, Jr., entered Tripoli harbor, tied up to the Frigate, PHILADELPHIA, which had been captured by the Tripolitans, and within 20 minutes set the torch to PHILADELPHIA. The first INTREPID met her demise when called upon to enter the Bay of Tripoli once more, this time loaded with powder and explosive shells. While rescue ships waited at the mouth of the bay for the crew, there was a flash and tremendous explosion, then silence. There were no survivors. INTREPID had lived up to her name which is synonymous with "fearless, bold, courageous, and undaunted."

There were two more INTREPIDS between the first gallant ship and the present one, and while they were not ships of the line, they contributed to two areas that have always stood high on the list of importance to the Navy; the research and development of new tactics, techniques, and weapons; and training. The second INTREPID was an experimental "iron-built," steam, torpedo-ram commissioned in August 1874, and from that date until 16 May 1892, when she was decommissioned and sold, she steamed the Atlantic coast compiling research material for the Navy.






The third INTREPID was launched on 8 October 1904, at the Mare Island (California) Navy Yard, one of two 1800 ton steel sailing vessels built for the training of Navy landsmen and apprentices which she did until 16 August 1907. At this time she was placed in service in San Francisco as a receiving ship, and later as a barracks for men of the Pacific Fleet's F-boats. After 17 years of service, she was placed out of commission on 30 August 1921 and sold on 20 December of that year.

It was with remarkable prescience that the keel of the present INTREPID was laid on 1 December 1941. The whole world was then at war, but the United States was not. Neither was there an immediate need for powerful new warships, but six days later, when the Japanese struck their infamous and crippling blow at Pearl Harbor, the United States had both problems - the war and the need for new ships. INTREPID was an ideal solution.

INTREPID's sister ships, the LEXINGTON (CV-16), ESSEX (CV-9) and YORKTOWN (CV-10) were already entering or preparing to enter the war. Following the formal champagne christening on 26 April 1943, the final touches were completed and INTREPID was commissioned on 16 August 1943. Speaking to the crew after the ceremony Captain T. L. Sprague, the ship's new captain, initiated the continuance of INTREPID's tradition by saying ". . . only in the cool courage and fearless bravery of the present crew, will the heroic and undaunted crews of the past live again." INTREPID then went to the War.





# Commanding Officer

Captain C. S. Williams, Jr.

Captain Charles S. Williams, Jr., became Commanding Officer of the INTREPID after serving as Commanding Officer of the USS PLATTE (AO-24).

Born in San Pedro, California, Captain Williams enlisted in the Navy in September 1940 and served his first tour of duty aboard the USS TENNESSEE (BB-43).

Shortly thereafter, he was selected to enter the U. S. Naval Academy and was commissioned an Ensign in June 1945. For the next two years, he served aboard the cruisers USS NASHVILLE (CL-43) and USS TOLEDO (CA-133).

In March 1949 he received his wings and was designated a Naval Aviator after completing 18 months of flight training. Subsequently, Captain Williams served in Patrol Squadron THIRTY-FOUR, Anti-submarine Squadron THIRTY, and was Commander of Anti-submarine Squadron THIRTY-FIVE and FORTY-ONE.

Captain Williams served on the staff of the Commander Naval Air Force Atlantic from 1954 to 1956. In 1960 and 1961, he served as the personal Aide to the Chief of Naval Personnel. While serving aboard USS KEARSARGE (CVS-33) in 1965 and 1966 as the ship's Navigator, he was awarded the Meritorious Unit Commendation. He served on the staff of the Director of ASW Programs in the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations from 1967 to 1969.

Pursuing his education, he received his Master of Arts Degree from Stanford University in 1959 and was graduated from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces in 1967.

While serving as Commanding Officer of the USS PLATTE in 1969 and 1970, he was awarded the Bronze Star for operations conducted off Vietnam.

# Commanding Officer

Captain R.H. Barker


Captain Raymond H. Barker became Commanding Officer of the INTREPID after serving as Commanding Officer of the USS WHITE PLAINS (AFS-4).

Captain Barker enlisted in the Navy in 1945 under the Naval Aviation College program as an Apprentice Seaman, and served at the University of California, Berkeley, the Naval Air Station, Seattle, and at Oregon State University until ordered to flight training in 1948. He was appointed an Aviation Midshipman in May 1948, and was designated a Naval Aviator in December 1949.

Captain Barker's first duty assignment was with VA-115 at North Island flying A-1 "Sky-raiders," as an Aviation Midshipman until commissioned an Ensign in May 1950. Other assignments include: Ass't Combat Information Officer, USS LEYTE (CVS-32); Aviation Safety Officer, ASW Officer, Operations Officer, VS-31; VS NATOPS Desk, Navy Tactical Doctrine Activity, Washington, D.C.; Executive Officer and Commanding Officer, VS-37; Commander, ASW Air Group 57; the CVA/CVW Warfare Desk in the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations; and Commanding Officer, USS WHITE PLAINS (AFS-4).

Captain Barker attended the General Line School at the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey; the Combat Information Officer's School at Glenview; the Aviation Safety Officer's School at the University of Southern California; the Air War College; and UCLA.

During his Naval career, Captain Barker received the Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Medal with seven gold stars, and the Navy Commendation Medal, while serving with VA-115 aboard the USS PHILIPPINE SEA (CVA-47) during 1950 - 1952 and the Bronze Star while Commander ASW Air Group 57.





# Executive Officer

Cdr. Lee E. Levenson

Commander Lee E. Levenson became Executive Officer of the INTREPID in July 1972 after serving as the ship's Navigator for ten months.

Born and raised in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Cdr. Levenson is a graduate of the University of Pittsburgh with a degree in Business Administration. He entered flight training in February 1952, received his commission and was designated a Naval Aviator in June 1953.

Cdr. Levenson has served in Patrol Squadron EIGHT, Antisubmarine Squadron THIRTY-NINE and in Antisubmarine Squadron TWENTY-NINE as Executive Officer and Commanding Officer. Additional assignments have included a tour in the Basic Training Command, duty aboard the USS ESSEX (CVS-9) and a tour in the Bureau of Naval Personnel.

He is a graduate of the General Line School, the Air War College and the Naval War College.

His awards include the Naval Commendation Medal, Navy Expeditionary Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, National Defense Service Medal and Vietnam Service Medal.

RADM J. G. Finneran



John Glennon Finneran was born in New York City, on July 23, 1924. Following graduation from the Naval Academy in 1946, he joined the USS WALKE and in September 1947 reported as an instructor at the Naval Academy Preparatory School, Bainbridge, Maryland. He remained there until October 1948, then reported as Engineer on board the USS KLEINSMITH. From November 1950 to January 1952 he had similar duty in the USS DOUGLAS H. FOX, after which he continued service afloat as Executive Officer and from October 1952 Commanding Officer of the USS PIMA COUNTY.

He was Commanding Officer of the USS MEREDITH during her Fleet Rehabilitation and Modernization period at the Philadelphia Naval Shipyard and in April 1961 became Executive Officer. In September 1962 he assumed command of the USS SAMPSON.

Assigned in December 1963 to the Bureau of Naval Personnel, Navy Department, Washington, D.C., he served as Navy Member of the Department of Defense Military Compensation Study Group and Navy Member of the Joint Military-Federal Civil Service Comparability Section, Overseas Placement Officer and Navy Member of the Department of Defense Military Compensation Study Group. Between January and July 1965 he was a member of the Secretary of the Navy's Retention Task Force in the Office of the Secretary of the Navy, after which he had instruction at the National War College, Washington, D.C.
